- 101:** Viña Aljibes 2014, Spain **€23.00**
Grape Variety: Sauvignon Blanc **Pichet €8.00**
Straw-coloured with tropical fruit & fermentation aromas.
Long & elegant on the palate with refreshing acidity.
- 102:** Apaltagua Gran Verano 2013/2014, Chile **€23.00**
Grape Variety: Chardonnay **Pichet €8.00**
Fruit forward wine, perfectly ripened to obtain optimal maturity.
- 103:** Fiordaliso 2013, Italy **€23.00**
Grape Variety: Pinot Grigio **Pichet €8.00**
Dry, soft and light with crisp, mouthfilling fruit.
- 104:** Fiordaliso Blush 2013, Italy **€23.00**
Grape Variety: Pinot Grigio
This wine takes its delicate pink colour from the grey tinted skins of the pinot grigio grapes.
- 105:** Moncaro 2014, Marche, Italy **€26.00**
Grape Variety: Trebbiano / Verdicchio
Fruit driven, floral bouquet with hints of white spring flowers, leading to a fresh delicate finish.

106: Chateau Taulusson 2013-2014, Bordeaux, France **€27.00**

Grape Variety: Sauvignon Blanc

Crisp, fresh with that acidity that makes Bordeaux Sauvignon stand out from the crowd. Sea Food and lighter dishes are an ideal accompaniment.

107: Grand Cape 2013/2014 Western Cape, South Africa **€29.00**

Grape Variety: Chenin Blanc

A fresh, dry chenin with broad appeal displaying classic baked apple and zippy citrus aromas with soft, delicate apple fruit on the palate well balanced by crisp acidity.

108: Soldiers Block 2014/2015 McLaren Vale, Australia **€32.00**

Grape Variety: Chardonnay

This vibrant peachy chardonnay exhibits all the rich mouth feel, weight and generosity of fruit expected offering more elegant melon and citrus characters.

109: Domaine Muret 2013/2014, Languedoc, France **€32.00**

Grape Variety: Picpoul de Pinet

What is not to like in a Picpoul de Pinet, starting with the lovely floral aromas and the long persistence of flavours. Crisp like a Sauvignon blanc or a Pinot Grigio but so much more.

110: Moko Black 2014, Marlborough, New Zealand **€34.00**

Grape Variety: Sauvignon Blanc

Passion fruit, citrus and gooseberry notes dominating the nose. Lovely fruit weight with great length and vibrancy.

111: La Cote Blanche 2013/2014 Pouilly Fume, France **€39.00**

Grape Variety: Sauvignon Blanc

An impeccable balance of summer meadow aromas, citrus fruit flavour and distinct mineral character.

112: Viña Aljibes 2014, Spain **€23.00**

Grape Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon **Pichet €8.00**

This wine has an intense color with aromas of ripe fruit, minerals & spices. Aged for 12 months. It is structured and velvety in the mouth with overtones of fruit.

113: Gran Verano 2013/2014, Chile **€23.00**

Grape Variety: Merlot **Pichet €8.00**

Fresh fruit aromas with a touch of cherry. It displays an elegant finish with soft, round tannins.

114: Chateau Les Barthes 2013, Bergerac, France **€26.00**

Grape Variety: Merlot / Cabernet Sauvignon / Cabernet France

Personally recommended by Jean-Luc Pouteau (Best Sommelier in the World) you cannot go wrong. Medium Bodied wine that just oozes sophistication

115: Apalatagua Gran Verano 2014, Valle Central, Chile **€27.00**

Grape Variety: Carmenere

Complex aromas where mature red and black fruits combine. It is a full-bodied wine with well-balanced acidity, rounded out by an intense persistent finish.

116: Cape Heights Reserve 2014, Western Cape, South Africa **€30.00**

Grape Variety: Pinotage

Medium bodied red with dark rich fruit and a touch of spice. Perfectly balanced and structured with excellent length through to the finish.

- 117:** Soldiers Block 2013/2014, McLaren Vale, Australia **€32.00**
Grape Variety: Shiraz
Well-structured with black fruits. Medium bodied and well balanced with soft oak tannins a true gem and it really stands out from the crowd.
- 118:** Burlesque 2013, Lodi, California, USA **€32.00**
Grape Variety: Zinfandel
Old Vine Zinfandel subjected to a “little” oak aging, big and beefy nose, delivering a generous gush of raspberry and spice.
- 119:** Dragunera Terra Siciliane 2013/2014, Sicily, Italy **€35.00**
Grape Variety: Nero d’Avola
A full-bodied Nero with hints of ripe blackberry, black pepper, dark cherries, licorice, violets and chocolate.
- 120:** Colono Crianza 2011, Rioja Alavesa, Italy **€37.00**
Grape Variety: Tempranillo / Graciano
Powerful, smart & rich in shades. Cherry intense colour really vivid. Nice texture with firm tannins, well worked by the aging process.
- 121:** Domaine du grand Serres 2014, Vacqueyras, France **€42.00**
Grape Variety: Grenache / Syrah / Mourvedre
This wine is from a real gem of an Appellation. Robust, Rich and powerful, yet smooth and elegant on the palate.
- 122:** Moko Black 2011/2012, Marlborough, New Zealand **€42.00**
Grape Variety: Pinot Noir
A medium bodied palate with flavors of plum, ripe cherry and a touch of cedar, dry finish with a fine tannins structure exuding elegance.

123: Aljibes 2010, Tierra de Castilla, Spain **€48.00**

Grape Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon / Merlot / Cabernet Franc

An interesting and aromatic red wine blend of three grapes.

Aged in barrels of French oak for 12 months.

Robert Parker 92 points.

124: CH La Croix Mazeran 2012/2013, St. Emilion Grand Cru **€49.00**

Grape Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon / Merlot / Cabernet Franc

Deep colour with aromas of blackberries, violets, and vanilla,

harmonised With hints of oak. Powerful yet gentle and silky

with a lingering aftertaste.

125: Poggio Della Faine 2009, Tuscany (Super Tuscan), Italy **€60.00**

Grape Variety: Sangiovese / Cabernet Sauvignon

This "Super Tuscan" is divine. Flavors from marinated cherries

and plums, to juicy blackberries and tasty pepper notes. The

wine is velvety soft and nestles on the palate.

126: Arione Barolo 2007/2008, Piemonte, Italy **€85.00**

Grape Variety: Nebbiolo

This wine ages for three years in large Slovakian oak barrels

and has a delicate, intense bouquet and a full complex

harmonic body. It is a classic elegant Barolo.

127: Terra Serena Prosecco Spumante, Valdobbiadene, Italy **€38.00**

Grape Variety: Prosecco

Pleasantly aromatic, slightly mineral, dry and fresh with

good acidity and a long finish. Excellent as an aperitif,

with appetisers and seafood.

128: Terra Serena Prosecco, Veneto, Italy **Snipe €8.50**

Grape Variety: Prosecco

Light straw yellow. Creamy mousse with a persistent

cascade of bubbles. Prosecco as it should be.
